EEFORE TEE RAILROAD COMIISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNAA

In the Matter of the Appilcation of D. NOYERS, doing business as NOYERS STAGES, for a certificate of pubife convendence and necessity to operate a seasonal passenger stage service between Fresno and points iocated on Eass Lake and to consolidete said certificate with the existing cerさifi-) cates of applicant.

BY THE COMAISSION:
QPINION

This is an applicetion by D. Moyers, doing business as Moyers Stages, requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a seasonal passenger stage service between Fresno and points on Bass Lake in the area south of Yosemite National Park, also serving points on soid route intermediate between Fresno and Bass Lake. The extreme length of the route is approximately 65 miles.

Applicant proposes to transport passengers, baggage and shpments of express weighing not to exceed 100 pounds each, on passenger carrying vehicles oniy.

In fustification for the granting of the authority sought, applicant alleges that

There are a mumber of resorts, places of business and private homes Iocated on Bass Inke ot or in the vicinity of points know as The pines, Freemans Lodge, The Falis, The Forks and Wishoma The public residing in the vicintty of these places is demanding service from appijo cant for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express, this service to be rendered between the approximate dates of May: 15 and September I5 of each year.

Applicant formeriy rendered service to poirits on Eass Laxe, operating over a route via Friant to The Pines and serving intermediate points, but, owing to the fact that the operation was not producing sufficient revenue to"insure out-of-pocket operating (I) expenses, the Comission authorizedits abandonment.

It is allesed by applicant that the Friant-The Pines operation was over dirt roads which were not kept in good condition, and were "narrov, crooked and hazardous", which resulted in costiy bus operation This difficulty has now been lergely overcome, by reason of improved condition of the highway through Coarsegold and Oekhurst to Eissott Corner, thence via U.S. Forest Highway 74 between Eissott Corner and Bass Lake, upon which are located the points hereinabove referred to in applicant's allegation.

Attached to the application is a statement setiling forth the fares which applicant proposes to charge together with time schedules. Two daily schedules eaci way are proposed, leaving Fresno at 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. and leeving The Pines at 11:30 a.man and 5:30 p.m. The single farc between these points is $\$ 3$; roundtrip, \$5.40. Express rotes will be in accordance with applicant's existing express tariff. The service would be inaugurated on May 15, 1945, or as soon thereaftcr as possible. Applicant alleges that there is no passenger comon carrier service now avaliable between the points which he proposes to serve:

It appears that the service proposed by applicant is in the public interest, and the application will be granted. There is no neecssity for a public hearing.

D. Hoyers is horeby pleced upon notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may be capitalized or used as an element of value in rate-fixing for any amount of money in excess of that originaliy paid to the State as the consideration for the grant of such rights.: Aside from their purely permissive aspect, they extend to the holder a full or partial monopoly of a class of business over a particular route. This monopoly feature may be changed or destroyed at any time by the State, which is not in any respect ilmited to the number of rights which may be given.

## ORDER

Application havine been made as above entitied and it havine been found that public convenience and necessity so reouire,

## IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to D. Moyer's authorizing the establishment and operation of service as passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section $2 t$ of the Public Utilities fct, for the transportation of passengers; baggage and express on passencer carrying vehicles, between Fresno and Bass Lake; said service to be seasonal between approximately May 15 and'September 15 of each calendar year, and to be consolideted with applicent's existing certificates, subject to the foliowing condition:

[^0](2) That in the operation of said passenger stage
service, D. Movers shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
2. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective. date hereof.
2. Applicant shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General order No. $93-\mathrm{A}$ by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time schedules within sixty ( 60 ) days from the effective date horeof and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public.
3. Subject to the authority of the Commission to change or modify it by further order, applicant shall conduct operations, pursuant to the certificate herein granted, over and along the following route:

Beginning at Fresno, over State Highway 41 to Bissott Corner via Coarsegold and Oakhurst, thence via.U.S. Forest Highway 74 between Bissott Corner and Bass Lake, serving The Pines, Freeman Lodge and The Falls, on the northern boundary of Bass Lake, and The Fords and•Wshon on the southern boundary of bass Lake.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
