BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

California Water Service Company, a corporation, asks the Commission for authority to enter into an agreement for supplying water for fire protection service to the Dalmo Victory Plant of The Goldfield Consolidated Mines Company in the City of San Carlos, San Mateo County.

The Dalmo Victory Plant of the mines company is an industrial consumer of the water company. The agreement herein provides for the installation of 5,700 feet of 8-inch main for fire protection purposes at a cost of \$21,500. The water company agrees to deliver to the plant a maximum flow of one thousand (1,000) gallons of water per minute at sixty-five (65) pounds pressure. The annual revenue from this service is estimated to be \$300. However, the main will be owned by the water company and water will be supplied from it to consumers applying for service.

The agreement further provides that the mines company will advance \$12,250 to the water company toward the cost of installing the main. This advanced sum will be refunded over a ten-year period on the basis of 20% of the

annual gross revenue obtained from consumers receiving service directly from the extension. The rate of refund is a deviation from the 25% basis on advances for extensions.

It appearing that this is not a matter on which a hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that California Water Service Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for supplying water for fire protection purposes to The Goldfield Consolidated Mines Company under substantially the same terms and conditions as set forth in the agreement marked Exhibit "1" attached to the application.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that California Water Service Company, a corporation, file with this Commission within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
