FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

James C. Kelly and Thomas F. Thompson, doing business as Red Top Cab Co., having requested an extension of time within which to file tariffs and time tables and to begin operations as provided for in Decision No. 37683, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Service Regulation 2 appearing at Sheet 13 of said Decision No. 37683 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2. Applicants shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables on or before June 25, 1945 on not less than 10 days notice to the Commission and the public."

(2) That said Decision No. 37683 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.
