BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of SUTTER BUTTE CANAL CO., a corporation, for an Order prescribing a rate for water furnished by Applicant for the irrigation of Ladino Clover and for similar clovers, and for an increase in rates,

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION.

By application first filed on January 10, 1941, and by amended application filed October 30, 1941, Sutter Butte Canal Co. sought a general increase of at least ten per cent in the rates applied for the distribution and sale of water for irrigation purposes. Hearings were held before former Commissioners Riley and Havenner on June 27 and 28, and July 14, 1941, but the matter was not then submitted. Thereafter, the applicant requested the Commission to defer action upon the application until it again be requested to proceed: Not having received notice that a further hearing is desired, the Commission deems it appropriate to order the dismissal of the application without prejudice to the right of the applicant to again petition for a renewal of its application:

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application in the Sutter Butte Canal Co., above entitled; be and hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
