THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

W. A. Baxter is engaged as a highway contract and city carrier in the transportation of property for Pacific Electric Railway in connection with the construction, maintenance or removal of facilities for its operations in the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino. For reasons stated in Decision No. 35554, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to perform this transportation at rates less than the established minimum rates. This authorization expires July 18, 1945. By supplemental application a one-year extension is sought.

The verified application discloses that the circumstances which warranted the previous minimum rate departures continue in effect; that operations under the authorized rates have been profitable; and that no material change in the conditions surrounding the transportation involved which would make the operations unprofitable during the period of the proposed extension is anticipated.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority granted W. A. Baxter by Decision No. 37205 of July 18, 1944, in the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to July 18, 1945, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective July 18, 1945.
