THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

For reasons stated in Decision No. 35320 of May 5, 1942, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to transport bakery goods for National Biscuit Company and Loose-Wiles Biscuit Company in a routed delivery service, at rates less than the established minimum rates. The shipments originate in San Francisco and Oakland and are delivered at points within the cities and at various points along defined routes extending to Willits, Calistoga, Suisun, Bakersfield, Tracy and San Jose. This authority expires July 11, 1945. By verified supplemental application a one-year extension of the authority is sought.

The supplemental application discloses that the reasons upon which the previous minimum rate deviations were predicated continue to obtain; that there has been no material change in the method or cost of the operations performed under the authorized rates since this matter was last considered a year ago, and that these rates are compensatory.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration of the authority granted Walkup Drayage and Warehouse Company by Decision No. 37200 of July 11, 1944, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to July 11, 1946, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.
