BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to construct, maintain and operate a spur track in and along Opal Avenue and across Carlsbad Avenue, near the Town of Mentone, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Carlsbad Avenue and Opal Avenue in Mentone, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application. Carlsbad Avenue is not now improved at the point of crossing and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the spur track. The crossing over Opal Avenue shall be identified as Crossing No. 2U-12.7-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not

complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
