BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The County of Fresno is authorized to construct a County
Road at grade across the main track of the Tracy-Fresno westside line
of Southern Pacific Company near the Town of Kerman in Fresno County,
to be identified as Crossing No. BA-191.9. Applicant shall bear
entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines
two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maint-
enance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall not be less
than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent.
Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72.
Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order
applicant shall so advise the Commission, in writing. This authori-
zation shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time
be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or
safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
