BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to construct spur track at grade across 13th Street in Madera, Madera County, at the location described in the application. Applicant alleges that 13th Street is not improved or traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of a crossing with rail track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
