BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

Applicant Bruce W. Robb, doing business as Tassajara Hot Springs Stage, holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Commission authorizing seasonal operation as a passenger stage corporation between Salinas and Tassajara Hot Springs. His application recites that Tassajara Hot Springs will not be opened for business during the 1945 season and hence there is no need for the transportation service which applicant was authorized to render and which he now asks permission to suspend temporarily.

In view of these circumstances, there appears no reason why applicant should not be permitted to suspend operation of the service, and the order herewith will so direct. A public hearing is not necessary.

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Bruce W. Robb is hereby authorized to suspend until May 1, 1946, the operation of his service for the

transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Salinas and Tassajara Hot Springs, as set forth in Decision No. 25928.
