BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The verified application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY dis-  
closes that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at  
applicant's station of Rockbank for more than two years and that con-  
tinued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized  
to abandon its non-agency station of Rockbank, County of Ventura; to  
eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tar-  
iffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one  
day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the fac-  
ilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commis-  
sion in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exer-  
cised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be  
effective immediately.
