BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY is authorized to install two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G.O. 75-B) at the crossing of Henry Ford Avenue, Los Angeles, with its Long Beach-Wilmington Line (Crossing No. 6LD-3.69) and to remove the wigwag and crossing sign now protecting said crossing. Said signal shall be located substantially as shown on the map attached to the application and shall be controlled by track circuits complying with the requirements of our General Order No. 75-B.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
