SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 37184 in this proceeding authorized Walkup Drayage and Warehouse Co. to transport property within San Francisco for Butler Brothers at a rate less than the established minimum rates until July 11, 1945.<sup>1</sup> Under this authorization the carrier may observe a rate of 11 cents per 100 pounds, subject to a minimum charge of 30 cents per shipment and a minimum weight of 5,000 tons per calendar year, without regard to the weight or classification of the individual shipments transported. By supplemental application extension of the authority to December 31, 1945, is sought.

The verified supplemental application discloses that there has been no material change in the circumstances and conditions surrounding this transportation since this matter was last considered a year ago; that extension of the expiration date of the authority will place it in consonance with the calendar year method of stating the minimum tonnage required to be transported. Applicant proposes to make a study before the authorization herein

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Deviation from the established minimum rates was authorized upon a showing that the shipper performs certain services ordinarily rendered by the carrier; that the traffic in question involves certain inherent operating economies and is substantially different from the transportation for which the minimum rates are prescribed.

sought expires to determine the specific cost of performing the transportation.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Walkup Drayage and Warehouse Co. by Decision No. 37184 of July 11, 1944, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to December 31, 1945, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.
