BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct one side track at grade across Washington Avenue, Apple Avenue, and an alley located in Tract No. 3757; Arlington Avenue, and an alley located in Tract No. 3758; and also a spur track across Apple Avenue, all in the City of Torrance, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. The alleys in Tract No. 3757 and Tract No. 3758 and Apple Avenue are not now improved at the point of crossing and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said alleys and street across existing track or tracks herein authorized. The crossings over Washington and Arlington Avenues shall be identified as a portion of existing crossings No's. 2-E-7.4 and 2-E-7.5, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection at

Washington Avenue shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs.

(G.O. 75-B.) The existing protection of one Standard No. 3 wignag and one Standard No. 1 crossing sign at Arlington Avenue is deemed sufficient under present conditions.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
