BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The City of Burbank has requested authority to construct Mariposa Street and Pass Avenue at grade across the Chatsworth Branch of Southern Pacific Company in that city. A publicly used crossing has existed at Mariposa Street for many years which is to be reconstructed and established as a public crossing. Southern Pacific Company has agreed to bear twenty-five per cent of the cost of reconstructing this crossing.

It is hereby ordered that the City of Burbank is authorized to construct Mariposa Street and Pass Avenue at grade across the Chatsworth Branch of Southern Pacific Company at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. BY-466.02 and No. BY-464.25 respectively.

Applicant shall bear seventy-five per cent of the cost of constructing Crossing No. BY-466.02 and the entire expense of constructing Crossing No. BY-464.25. Southern Pacific Company shall bear the remainder of the cost of constructing Crossing No. BY-466.02. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost of both crossings outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on the plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. 75-B) at each location.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
