BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 35368 of May 12, 1942, as amended, in this proceeding authorized applicant to lease 60,628 square feet of its public utility warehouse space on Terminal Island to California Shipbuilding Corporation and/or the United States Maritime Commission; to suspend operation of the space covered by the lease until May 12, 1945; and to conduct operations in other facilities on Terminal Island. By verified supplemental application filed July 18, 1945, applicant requests a two-year extension of this authority. The supplemental application discloses that the continued occupancy by lessees of the space here involved is necessary in connection with their war activities.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the sought authority is justified. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority granted Crescent Warehouse Company, Limited, by Decision No. 35368 of May 12, 1942, as amended, in this proceeding be and it is hereby reinstated and extended to May 12, 1947, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

Inasmuch as the authority expired May 12, 1945, the application will be considered as a request for reinstatement.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Crescent Warehouse Com-
pany, Limited, shall, immediately upon exercising the authority here-
in granted to suspend operation of the space permitted to be leased,
amend its tariffs on file with the Commission on not less than one
(1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public to show that
operations have been suspended as authorized herein; and that the
authority to establish and operate additional space herein granted is
subject to the condition that such space shall not be operated unless
and until tariffs on file with the Commission are amended accordingly.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
