OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 35801 authorized Gray Line Motor Tours Co., to suspend all its sightseeing services until further order of the Commission. Such suspension was based on General Order No. 10 of the Office of Defense Transportation prohibiting the type of service performed. By its application, applicant states that such prohibition has been revoked and the Railroad Commission is requested to terminate such suspension.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the suspension authorized by Decision No. 35801 shall terminate as of September 1, 1945, and Gray Line Motor Tours Co. is hereby authorized to reestablish its suspended service on or immediately thereafter, and file appropriate tariffs and time tables within 30 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.
