ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an extension to a spur track at grade across the southeasterly edge of State Highway Route No. 49 in the Town of Oakville, Napa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. AB-57.3-C.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rail flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 3 per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless further time be granted or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or nullified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
