OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding, Harbor District Warehouse Company requests authority to suspend its public utility warehouse operations on Mormon Island in the City of Los Angeles until February 27, 1947. The verified application shows that the United States Government secured possession of applicant's warehouse property by a court order and is now occupying these premises under a lease terminating February 27, 1947.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that granting of the sought authority is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Harbor District Warehouse Company be and it is hereby authorized to suspend operations as a public utility warehouseman at Mormon Island in the City of Los Angeles until February 27, 1947, unless sooner changed, canceled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Harbor District Warehouse Company shall forthwith amend its tariffs on file with the Commission on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public to show that its operations have been suspended as authorized herein.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
