FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

The Commission, on June 19, 1945, rendered Decision No. 37990 authorizing applicant to operate a passenger stage service between California Point Junction and Tiburon, Marin County, via the proposed Navy Ammunition Dump at California Point, serving intermediate points. The order in said decision required applicant to file tariffs and time schedules within sixty days from the effective date of the order.

It now develops that the construction of the proposed Navy Ammunition Dump at California Point has been delayed due to protests made to the Federal Government by residents of this area against the construction of said dump at this particular location. This delay in construction has delayed the construction and improvement of the road over which applicant will be required to operate in performing the service authorized by said decision. For this reason, applicant desires an extension of the time to six months within which to file tariffs and time schedules.

The request for additional time appears to be reasonable and the order will be modified in accordance with the request. A public hearing is not necessary.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which applicant shall comply with service regulation (2) of the order in Decision No. 37990 shall be six (6) months from the date of said decision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects, said Decision No. 37990 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
