FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

On February 27, 1945, the Commission issued its Decision No. 37691 authorizing passenger stage service by applicant during the entire year between San Luis Obispo and Cambria and intermediate points. It is now alleged by applicant that nearly 75 per cent of the population in the Cambria area reside between Cambria and Cambria Pines, the latter point being approximately one mile north of Cambria. Other business establishments, including a hotel and garage, are located at Cambria Pines. No public transportation is presently available between Cambria and Cambria Pines.

In this application, it is alleged that public convenience and necessity require that the service heretofore authorized to Cambria be extended to include Cambria Pines. It appears that the extension requested is in the public interest and the order in Decision No. 37691 will accordingly be amended to permit service to Cambria Pines. A public hearing is not necessary.

FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph (2) of the order in Decision No. 37691, appearing on sheet 3 of said decision, be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"(2) That Pacific Greyhound Lines is hereby authorized to render passenger stage service during the entire year between San Luis Obispo and Cambria Pines and intermediate points. In the exercise of the authority herein granted, applicant shall observe the following service regulations:"

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No. 37691 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
