ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

It appearing that in February of 1943 Harry Mahaffey was authorized to transport passengers between Tracy and the U.S. Army Quartermaster Corps Sub-Depot at Lyoth and intermediate points; it appearing further that Harry Mahaffey has not filed annual reports covering the years 1943 and 1944; it appearing further that service has been discontinued; therefore, good cause appearing, it is found that Harry Mahaffey is no longer conducting and has abandoned said passenger stage service, and therefore

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate issued by Decision No. 36175 in Application No. 25507 be and it hereby is revoked, and schedules and tariffs on file cancelled; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless said Harry Mahaffey, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
