ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

In 1921 a limited highway common carrier certificate, between San Francisco and points in Santa Clara County north of San Jose and in San Mateo County, was issued to L. Scatena & Co. and A. Galli Fruit Co. Consolidated. (Decision No. 9199, Application No. 6693.) In 1933 Edward J. Schivo was authorized to acquire said operative right. (Decision No. 26020, Application No. 18908.)

It appearing that Edward J. Schivo has had no effective insurance on deposit with the Commission since June 4, 1942, as required by General Order No. 91; it appearing further that he has not filed quarterly reports of gross revenue for the third and fourth quarters of 1942, nor for any period thereafter to date; it appearing further that he has not filed annual reports covering the years 1942, 1943, and 1944; it appearing further that service has been discontinued; therefore, good cause appearing, it is found that Edward J. Schivo is no longer conducting and has abandoned said highway common carrier service, and therefore

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right created by Decision No. 9199 in Application 6693, and acquired by Edward J.

Schivo pursuant to Decision No. 26020 in Application No. 18908, be and hereby is revoked, and schedules and tariffs on file cancelled; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless said Edward J. Schivo, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
