THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

ORIGINAL

By Decision No. 37520, dated September 1, 1942, the Commission authorized Pacific Greyhound Lines to suspend its passenger stage service between Half Moon Bay and San Gregorio, and between Pescadero and Davenport for a period of one year ending September 1, 1943. By Decision No. 36635, dated September 28, 1943, a further suspension of this service was extended until September 1, 1944. Subsequent to this, and on August 29, 1944, authority to suspend was again extended to September 1, 1945.

By its third supplemental application, applicant requests authority to continue the suspension of that service for an additional period of time ending May 1, 1946, unless public convenience and necessity justify an earlier resumption of such service.

As justification for the proposed continued suspension applicant asserts, in effect, that at the present time there is no public need for a resumption of such service. It is further stated that the same conditions exist as alleged in its previous applications which were, in substance, that war conditions have imposed heavy obligations on it to divide its stock of passenger

stage equipment and personnel of employees to the most beneficial use conducive to the war effort.

It appears that applicant should be authorized to continue suspension of this service for a further period ending May 1, 1946. This carrier is hereby placed on notice that no further extension of time will be granted. This is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary.

THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The above entitled matter having been duly considered and the Commission being fully advised therein;

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines is hereby authorized to suspend, until May 1, 1946, all passenger service between Half Moon Bay and San Gregorio and intermediate points and between Pescadero and Davenport and intermediate points, subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicant shall immediately supplement its tariffs and time tables to reflect the foregoing authority.
2. That the suspended service may be resumed upon not less than ten (10) days' notice to the Commission and the public prior to the expiration of the period of suspension herein specified, and upon compliance with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 79 and 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
