OPINION AND ORDER

ORIGINAL

Elva De Pue Matthews, an individual doing business as De Pue Warehouse Company, operates public utility warehouses at numerous points in the Sacramento Valley, including Orland. By this application, she requests authority to sell her warehouse property located in Orland to Wm. A. Vereschagin for the sum of \$11,500, payable in cash. The verified application shows that the seller desires to discontinue the warehouse business at Orland and that the purchaser will maintain the same rates and service to the public.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Elva De Pue Matthews, doing business as De Pue Warehouse Company, be and she is hereby authorized to sell and Wm. A. Vereschagin be and he is hereby authorized to purchase the public utility warehouse property involved in this proceeding; and that, immediately upon transfer of the property involved, applicants shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public, supplement or reissue the tariff on file with the Commission, in so far as it names rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations of Elva De Pue Matthews,

doing business as De Pue Warehouse Company, at Orland, to show that she has withdrawn or canceled and that Wm. A. Vereschagin has concurrently adopted or established as his own, said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
