



Therefore, the Commission being of the opinion that the public convenience and necessity so requires,

IT IS ORDERED that a certificate be and hereby is granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to construct, operate, and maintain the electric transmission and distribution line and facilities described in Application No. 25747, and the exercise of all rights, permits, franchises or easements essential thereto, subject to the condition, however, that no claim of value for such certificate herein granted shall be made in excess of the actual cost thereof.
