O R D E R

By Decision No. 32474, dated October 17, 1939, Pacific Electric Railway Company was exempted from compliance with Section VI (d) of General Order No. 75-A, (75-B) at the crossing of Olympic Boulevard (Crossing No. 6S-7.31) and Fairfax Avenue (Crossing No. 6S-7.38), located in the City of Los Angeles. Said exemption has not been taken advantage of. Numerous extensions of time have been issued. Subsequent to the rendering of Decision No. 32474 conditions have materially changed and the provisions of said order are no longer applicable.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 32474 is hereby revoked and Application No. 22723 is dismissed without prejudice.
