BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

In this application Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company requests authority to abandon its switching tracks on Sebastopol Avenue in the City of Santa Rosa. The track involved runs along the west side of Sebastopol Avenue from approximately Olive Street to a connection with a joint track of Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company and Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, a distance of approximately 1700 feet. One industry is served by a spur track leading from said track, and the owner thereof has signified that he has no objection to the abandonment of the track. All other industries served by the track proposed to be abandoned can be served by the above mentioned joint track.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company be and it is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its switching tracks located in Sebastopol Avenue west of Olive Street in the City of Santa Rosa, as shown in yellow color on the map (Drawing No. D-3987) attached to and made a part of the application, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The Commission shall be given written notice of the removal of said tracks within thirty (30) days thereafter.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.
