OPINION AND ORDER

The applicants herein are San Bernardino Valley Transit Company and Air Service Transit, Inc. Both operate passenger stage services within and without the city of San Bernardino. McKinley Transportation Company operates a service entirely within the limits of San Bernardino city. A transfer system is proposed to be inaugurated by these carriers in accordance with a certain agreement entered into by the parties on February 11, 1945, a copy of which is attached to the application. The agreement provides that joint fares will be established for transportation between points within the carriers' 6-cent and 10-cent fare zones and that the through service will be provided without additional charge for the transfer privileges involved. It has been approved by the Mayor and Common Council of the city of San Bernardino, and by its terms will become effective upon approval by the Railroad Commission and the filing by applicants of tariffs embodying the fare revisions in question.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the proposed agreement should be approved.
