O R D E R

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to construct an industrial track at grade across Lassen Avenue (County Road), to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BD-253.0, and two industrial tracks at grade across Ninth Street, to be identified as Crossing No. BD-253.18-C, at locations as described in the application, both crossings near the town of Huron, Fresno County. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign at Crossing No. BD-253.0, and by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at Crossing No. BD-253.18-C (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
