TENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

For reasons set forth in Decision No. 30767, as amended, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to transport property for the Western States Grocery Company and Safeway Stores, Inc. from Stockton and Tracy to certain designated points in central California, at rates less than the prescribed minimum rates, until November 5, 1945. Extension of this authority for a one-year period is sought. The verified supplemental application alleges that no new conditions have arisen in applicant's operations since this matter was last considered a year ago and that the authorized rates continue to be profitable.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that a further extension for a period of one year is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted J. P. Spaenhower by said Decision No. 30767, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to November 5, 1946, unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
