ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 8228 in Application No. 6012, as modified by Decision No. 26822 in Application No. 19123, granted a certificate to Chew Chick authorizing the operation of an automobile truck line as a common cerrier of fresh fruits and vegetables and farm products between San Francisco and Sunnyvale and certain intermediate territory. Under date of October 23, 1945, Chew Chick informed the Commission as follows:

This is to advise that on or about Dec. 30, 1944 I disposed of all my trucking equipment but one truck and trailer to the Terven Packing Co. operating by Messer Craig and Renz of Mt. View.

This will be your authority to cancel the former Franchise Certificate that was issued to me as same is now dormant and has been since said date of April 20, 1945. I do not contemplate resuming business in the trucking line.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the highway common carrier operative rights created by the foregoing decisions are hereby revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Chew Chick and in effect, are hereby cancelled

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
