BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND ORDER

By verified application Lee E. Waggoner seeks a "For-Hire Vessel" permit to transport ships' stores and supplies between San Francisco and ships on San Francisco Bay and between said ships. The property transported will be exclusively for the account of the War Shipping Administration. An "on call" service, available 24 hours a day, will be provided. The equipment to be used will be self-propelled converted LCM Naval Landing Barges having a net carrying capacity of approximately 20 tons each. Additional equipment such as flat barges, barges with booms, and tugboats will also be used as conditions necessitate.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application meets the requirements of the "For-Hire Vessel Act."

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a "For-Hire Vessel" permit be and it is hereby issued to Lee E. Waggoner to operate vessels as described in this application between San Francisco and ships on San Francisco Bay and between said ships, via all navigable routes, for the transportation of ships' stores and supplies for War Shipping Administration.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in the operation of the service authorized in the preceding paragraph applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

1. File written acceptance of the permit herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date hereof.
2. File in triplicate a tariff containing rates, charges and regulations conforming with those filed with the application and specifying the shipper to be served as herein authorized within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
