9. OPINION AND ORDER

By verified application, George A. Chrisman, operating a public utility warehouse at Clements, seeks authority to lease this property and its equipment to Roy O. Hieb. It is alleged that Chrisman desires to retire because his health and advanced age do not permit him to continue the operations and that Hieb will carry on the business without change in the service available to the public or in the rates therefor.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that George A. Chrisman be and he is hereby authorized to lease to Roy O. Hieb the public utility property involved in this proceeding; that, immediately upon the leasing of the aforesaid property, George A. Chrisman and Roy O. Hieb shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public, supplement or reissue the tariff on file with the Commission, in so far as it names rates, rules and regulations governing the warehouse operations in question to show that the former has withdrawn or canceled and that the latter has concurrently adopted or

established as his own said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
