SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By the fourth supplemental order in this proceeding (Decision No. 36528, dated July 29, 1943), the Commission prescribed a time extension for refunds of advances for utility line or main extensions by reason of war conditions.

It appears necessary for the purpose of the rule prescribed by said fourth supplemental order in this proceeding that a date of the cessation of actual hostilities in World War II should be determined. It is therefore proposed that an Order be issued in this proceeding in substantially the following language:

"I. The time extension period prescribed by said fourth supplemental order, Decision No. 36528, and emergency rule and regulation, entitled "Time Extension for Refunds of Advance Deposit Contracts," ending "six months following cessation of hostilities" is established as ending _____.

"II. The elapsed time to be added to time limits specified in the extension rules for refund of unrefunded advance deposits on extension contracts entered into prior to December 7, 1941 shall be _____ years, _____ months, and _____ days.

"III. The elapsed time to be added to time limits specified in the extension rules for refund of unrefunded advance deposits on extension contracts entered into between December 7, 1941 and _____ shall be the elapsed time between the date of said contract and _____.

"IV. On or before _____ each utility shall notify the other party or parties to the contract as to the actual time extension of said contract under the terms of the orders in this proceeding, and shall continue to make such refunds within the added time extension.

"V. Upon completion of notification of all such contract holders, the utility shall by advice letter accompanied by an affidavit of notification, request cancellation of said emergency rule and regulation."

For the purpose of giving all interested parties an opportunity to present their views as to the foregoing proposed Order and other related matters,

IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby reopened for further hearing before Commissioner Rowell at the hour of 10 a.m., on Dec. 7th, 1945 in the Commission's Court Room, State Building, San Francisco.
