ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has applied for authority to abandon and remove its Daisy Avenue spur, to remove the track and electrical facilities therefrom, and to sell three parcels of property on which said Daisy Avenue spur, is located.

It appears that neither the track nor the property is required in the performance of any service to the public at this time or will be in the near future and that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that Facific Electric Railway Company is authorized to remove its Daisy Avenue spur track and electrical facilities, as more particularly shown in the application, extending from Engineering Station 114 \(\neq 93.4 \) to the connection with applicant's Long Beach Line at Los Cerritos, including the grade crossing identified as Crossing No. 6LA-16.09.

Applicant is also authorized to reclassify the three parcels of property described in the application from operative to non-operative property, subject to the condition that applicant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify the Commission in writing

of the completion of the reclassification of the above property herein authorized.

Within thirty days thereafter, applicant shall likewise report to the Commission the removal of said track. The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof unless further time is granted This order shall be effective immediately. by subsequent order.
