SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The first interim order in this Case, Decision No. 34848, required each gas, electric, water and telephone utility to file a supplement to their existing rules and regulations in order to comply with the National Defense program.

By the third supplemental order, Decision No. 36296, each gas utility coming under the provisions of War Production Board's Limitation Order L-31 (subsequently renumbered Order U-7) was ordered to file an emergency rule and regulation in order to comply with that federal order.

The War Production Board revoked its Orders U-1 and U-7 on September 30, 1945 and August 18, 1945, respectively. The need for said emergency rules and regulations no longer exists, and utilities should be authorized to request cancellation of said rules, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that:

I. Each gas, electric, water and telephone utility is hereby authorized to request cancellation by advice letter of said emergency rule and regulation originally filed in accordance with the first interim order, Decision No. 34848.

II. Each gas utility that operated under the provisions of War Production Board's Order U-7 is hereby authorized to request cancellation by advice letter of said emergency rule and regulation filed in accordance with the third supplemental order, Decision No. 36296.

This Order shall be effective on the date hereof.
