In the Matter of the application of the City of Visalia, a municipal corporation of the State of California, for an order of the Railroad Commission authorizing applicant to construct a railroad crossing.

The City of Visalia, a municipal corporation of the State of California, has requested authority to construct East Race Street at grade across the Visalia Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in that city.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the City of Visalia is authorized to construct East Race Street at grade across six tracks of the Visalia Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2V-25.5.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails of each track. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall not be less than forty feet, and grade of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. 75-B.)

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-  
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or  
safety so require. This order shall become effective immediately.
