Evelyn M. Knapp and John P. Demeter, among their passenger stage operations, conduct one between Palo Alto and Menlo Park and intermediate points pursuant to the Commission's Decision No. 38190, over the route defined in the service regulations of the order of such decision. By their 4th Supplemental Application, the Commission is requested to modify the route slightly so that Olive Street may be used instead of Cotton Street in Menlo Park. The application states that the proposed change is based upon requests of residents on Cotton Street who are of the opinion that operation thereover constitutes a hazard to a number of children living on such street. This condition is not present on Olive Street, which is two blocks westerly of Cotton Street.

The proposed rerouting will not involve a change in the present local applicable fares, and only a slight change in the schedules of operation.

Applicants' request appears to be in the public interest and will be granted. No public hearing is necessary.

O R D E R

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the route described in service regulation 3 appearing at sheet 9 of Decision No. 38190, is deleted therefrom and the following substituted therefor:

"Beginning at the intersection of University Avenue and Alma Street (Palo Alto), thence along Alma Street, Palo Alto Drive, El Camino Real, Cambridge Avenue, Arbor Road, Middle Avenue, Olive Street, Santa Cruz Avenue, Merrill Street, Oak Grove Avenue, Pine Avenue, Ravenswood Avenue, Laurel Street to its intersection with Oak Grove Avenue."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 38190 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
