ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 18263, in Application No. 13707, authorized Paul Derkum to acquire a passenger stage operative right between Los Angeles and Wheeler's Hot Springs as created by Decision No. 15321, in Application No. 10585. Under date of November 10, 1945, Paul Derkum informed the Commission as follows:

In answer to your registered letter received on November 5, I will ask that the Los Angeles Wheeler Hot Springs operation be revoked. It would be useless to try to operate at a profit. I have made a complete survey of this since talking to you.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative right created by the foregoing decisions is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables applicable to service between Los Angeles and Wheeler's Hot Springs, on file with the Commission in the name of Paul Derkum, are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
