In their present locations; these loops involve turning movements at Queen and Market Streets in the heavily traveled business center and serve to further increase congested conditions:

Applicant has participated in the consideration of these problems and as a result, the present application seeks an enlargement of one loop and the relocation of the second; so that bus turning movements will be removed from the most acute traffic locations. No change is proposed in frequency of service, in fares or equipment to be operated; and

Commencing at the intersection of La Brea Avenue and Fairview Boulevard (City of Inglewood); thence via Fairview Boulevard, Buckler Avenue; Angelus Vista Boulevard, Valley Ridge Avenue, 54th Street; Crenshaw Boulevard, Slauson Avenue, Keniston Avenue; Gay Street; Hyde Park Boulevard, Florence Avenue; Centinela Avenue; La Brea Avenue; Regent Street; Locust Street; Manchester Avenue and La Brea Avenue to Regent Street;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that service regulation numbered 3(b) of Decision No. 35586; dated July 14; 1942; be amended to read as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of Regent Street and La Brea Avenue (City of Inglewood); thence via Regent Street; Redondo Boulevard; La Brea Avenue, Manchester Avenue; Firestone Boulevard, Long Beach Boulevard and Seville Avenue to off-street terminal at Seville Avenue and Palm Place (City of South Gate):
