O P I N I O N

San Diego Electric Railway Company operates a local street car and meter coach service in the City of San Diego and surrounding territory. By Decision No. 37737, dated March 20, 1945, in Application No. 26570, applicant was granted an in lieu certificate of public convenience and necessity covering all of its passenger stage operations, which certificate was amended by Decision No. 37955, dated June 5, 1945, in Application No. 26737.

Applicant requests that Decision No. 37737 be amended by adding an additional paragraph to the description of "Route E" in said decision, in and in the vicinity of La Mesa. Applicant alleges that the proposed service will serve three small groups of residences in the vicinity of the City of La Mesa, known respectively as La Mesa Dale, Vista La Mesa, and Rolando Village; that the nearest public transportation to these three groups of residences is applicant's present "Route E" bus line which traverses El Cajon Boulevard and La Mesa Boulevard; and that to better serve these three communities public convenience and necessity requires that public transportation be established over the route proposed in connection with its "Route E" bus line.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the description of "Route E" in the Order in Decision No. 37737 in Application No. 26570 (Sheet 4 of said Decision) be amended by adding the following description:

Commencing at the intersection of Palm Avenue and La Mesa Boulevard in the City of La Mesa; thence along Palm Avenue to Allison Avenue; thence along Allison Avenue to University Avenue; thence along University Avenue to Matagen Drive; thence along Matagen Drive to Rolando Boulevard; thence along Rolando Boulevard to El Cajon Boulevard.

For all other purposes the Order in Decision No. 37737 in Application No. 26570 and amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
