OPINION AND OFDER

In this application, as amended, S: C: Galt, Trustee for Hughson Varehouse Company, proposes to dispose of; and C. D. Wheeler and Roy M. Day, copartners, propose to acquire, public utility warehouse property located at Hughson, Stanislaus County. The verified application, as amended, alleges that Theeler and Day, who are experienced warehousemen, will maintain the same service and rates as those now available to the public at the warehouse involved.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

Warehouse Company, be and he is hereby authorized to dispose of the public utility warehouse property involved in this proceeding; that, immediately upon transfer of said property to C. D. Wheeler and Roy M. Day, copartners, the tariff on file with the Commission, in so far as it names rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations of S. C. Galt, Trustee for Hughson Warehouse Company, at Hughson, shall be supplemented or reissued, on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and to the public,

to show that S. C. Galt has withdrawn or canceled and that C. D. Wheeler and Roy M. Day, copartners, have concurrently adopted or established as their own, said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
