In the Matter of the Application of Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to relocate existing team track connection in Magnolia Avenue between Monroe and Jackson Streets, in the City of Riverside. Application No. 27096

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to relocate its one spur track at grade across Magnolia Avenue (Crossing No. 6W-5.40-C) in the City of Riverside at the new location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
