ORDER

Southern Pacific Company on October 25, 1945, applied for authority to abandon its Class "A" Seasonal Agency at Lockeford, County of San Joaquin, State of California, and to abandon and sell station building located at said station.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business has been transacted at said agency station during the past two (2) years, that no less-than-carload business has been transacted during the same period, and that carload shipments have been handled through its Lodi Agency during the past three years.

It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its Class "A" Seasonal Agency at its station of Lockeford, located on the Lodi Branch of its Western Division in San Joaquin County, as a station of record and to cancel all tariff rates to and from said station; and to abandon and sell said station building, subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall give not less than ten (10) days' notice to the public of said agency abandonment by posting notice at said station.
2. Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

3. The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
