BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct (a) a State highway at separated grades on State Highway Route No. 3 (Road III-Sut.-3-Y.C.) over the tracks of the Yuba City Branch of Southern Pacific Company in Yuba City, Sutter County, at the location as shown by map, Exhibit "A," attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. CY-146.87-A, and (b) a crossing at grade on the Yuba City Dump Road at the location as shown by map Exhibit "B," attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. CY-146.83-C.

The cost of construction and maintenance of said crossings shall be borne in conformity with an agreement entered into between applicant and Southern Pacific Company. A certified copy together with plans for said grade separation approved by the Southern Pacific Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Clearances of grade separation shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-C.

Construction of said grade crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-38 (38) feet measured along the center line of tracks, and grades of approach not greater than those shown

on map marked Exhibit "B" attached to the application. Protection shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
