OPINION AND ORDER

By this Commission's Decision No. 36796, dated January 4, 1944, in the 65th Supplement to Application No. 17984, Pacific Electric Railway Company was authorized among other things to institute a motor coach service along Balboa Boulevard between Birmingham Army Hospital and the Van Nuys Army Airdrome Headquarters. Applicant now requests that it be authorized to abandon this service and alleges that it was established to meet requirements of employees and military personnel to and from the Airdrome during war times; that the activities of the United States Army at said Airdrome have decreased lately and as a result travel is practically nil; and that the commanding officer at said Airdrome has requested the termination of said service.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to abandon motor coach service along Balboa Boulevard between Birmingham Army Hospital and Van Nuys Army Airdrome Headquarters along the route described as follows:

From Vanowen Street and Balboa Boulevard, via Balboa Boulevard to Van Nuys Army Airdrome headquarters located approximately midway between Saticoy Street and Roscoe Boulevard.

subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall give the Commission and the travelling public not less than one (1) day's notice of its intention to abandon said service.
2. Applicant shall cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all passenger rate tariffs and time schedules between said points.
3. Applicant shall within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission in writing of the abandonment of the passenger service herein authorized.

In all other respects Decision No. 36796 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
