## ORIGINAL

By the Order in Decision No. 38155 in 76th Supplemental' Application No. 19502, Key System was issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity to extend its service in and in the vicinity of Hayward over routes designated as "a" to "c" inclusive. One of the routes (No. 91 Castro Valley Line) over which it operates pursuant to this certificate is as follows:

From the intersection of "B" and Castro Streets; along "B" Street to Foothill Boulevard, along Foothill Boulevard to Mattox Road; along Mattox Road to Castro Valley Boulevard; along Castro Valley Boulevard to Redwood Road; along Redwood Road to Strobridge Avenue; along Strobridge Avenue to Orchard Avenue; along Orchard Avenue to Laurel Avenue; along Laurel Avenue to Redwood Road; along Redwood Road to "A" Street; along "A" Street to Third Street; along Third Street.to "B" Street; along "B" Street to the intersection of "B" and Castro Streets, looping via Castro Street, "A" Street, Watkins Street, and "B" Street.

Applicant new proposes to operate said No. 91 line over the following route:

From the intersection of Feethill Boulevard and Lower Road, along Foothill Boulevard to "B" Street, along "B" Street to Castre Street, thence via "B" Street to Third Street, along Third Street to "A" Street, along "A" Street to Rodwerd Road, along Rodword Road to Laurel Avenue, along Laurel Avenue to Orchard Avenue, along Orchard Avenue to Streetidge Avenue, along Streetidge Avenue to Rodword Road, along Redword Road to William Street, along William Street to Lake Chabet Road, along Lake Chabet Road, along Lake Chabet Road to Castre Valley Boulevard, along Castre Valley Boulevard, along Castre Valley Boulevard along Castre Valley Boulevard to Rodword Road, and return via balance of proviously described route.

Applicant alleges that the proposed change will provide better service to persons in Upper Castro Valley through the use of William Street which has recently been resurfaced and placed in an operative condition; that the proposed service will replace the present one-way loop service with two-way service; and that the proposed change has been requested by the Hayward Area Chamber of Commerce.

Applicant will require a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the proposed route to operate along Redwood Road from Castro Valley Boulevard to William Street, along William Street from Redwood Road to Lake Chabet Road, and along Lake Chabet Road from William Street to Castro Valley Boulevard.

With this plan, service will be discontinued ever Mattox Street from its intersection with Castro Valley Boulevard to its intersection with Foothill Boulevard. Applicant desires to retain operating rights over this route for use as needed.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

Key System is hereby placed upon notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may be capitalized or used as an element of value in rate-fixing for any amount of money in excess of that originally paid to the State as the consideration for the grant of such rights. Aside from their purely permissive aspect they extend to the helder a full or partial monopoly of a class of business over a particular route. This menopoly feature may be changed or destroyed at any time by the State which is not in any respect limited to the number of rights which may be given

## ORDER

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

I. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Key System, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Section 2% of the Public Utilities Act, as an extension and en-

largement of its present operative rights and consolidated therewith, for the transportation of passengers ever and along the following routes in the vicinity of Hayward, California, in addition to routes "a" to "e" inclusive, described in the Order of Decision No. 58155.

- p. Along Redwood Road from Castro Valley Boulevard to William Street.
- q. Along William Stroet from Rodwood Road to Lake Chabet Road.
- r. Along Lako Chabot Road from William Street to Castro Valley Boulevard.

In providing service pursuant to the foregoing cortificate the following service regulations shall be complied with:

- 1. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereef.
- 2. Applicant shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective appropriate tariffs and time schedules within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public.

II. Key System is authorized to suspend its operations over that portion of its No. 91 Meter Coach Line on Mattex Road between its intersection with Castro Valley Boulevard and its intersection with Foothill Boulevard, and retain operative rights over this route as needed.
