BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The County of Contra Costa is authorized to construct a public highway at grade across the tracks of the Sacramento Northern Railway between Bancroft and Meinert, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8-30.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four (24) feet and grades of approach not greater than three (3) per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
