

Decision No. 38530

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of CALIFORNIA WATER & TELEPHONE COMPANY, a corporation, for permission to give exchange telephone service to the unincorporated Town of Desert Hot Springs, Riverside County, California, and surrounding territory, and to publish, file and make effective rates for exchange service and for interexchange service in connection with said exchange telephone service.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

California Water & Telephone Company, on December 10, 1945, having filed schedules for exchange and toll service in the Desert Hot Springs exchange, and having requested in the Advice Letter that said schedules be made effective on December 17, 1945, which is less than the ten days provided for in Decision No. 37969, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraphs (2) and (4) of the order in Decision No. 37969 be amended to read as follows:

- "(2) California Water & Telephone Company is authorized to make effective in the Desert Hot Springs exchange on and after the date of the establishment of the service therein, the rates and charges for exchange service set forth in Exhibit 'C,' attached to the application, and is authorized to file the exchange area and base rate area maps shown in Exhibits 'A' and 'C,' respectively, attached to the application, provided said schedules and maps are filed with the Railroad Commission in accordance with General Order No. 96 on or before the fifth day immediately preceding the date of the establishment of said exchange."
- "(4) California Water & Telephone Company is authorized to establish message toll telephone service to and from Desert Hot Springs exchange, at rates and charges set forth in Exhibit 'B,' attached to the application, provided said schedule is filed with the Railroad Commission in accordance with General Order No. 96 on or before the fifth day immediately preceding the date of the establishment of said exchange."

This Order shall become effective immediately.
